Position Conditions/Qualifications: Requires: Bachelor's, Master or PhD degree or equivalent experience in a relevant scientific area and 1 at least year research experience using laboratory mice; demonstrated skills in mouse embryology, small animal surgery and colony maintenance.

Prefer: previous experience in at least one of the following techniques: microinjection of DNA/RNA into zygote (for **CRISPR gene editing**) or ES cells into blastocyst; maintenance of ES cell lines in tissue culture; *in vitro* fertilization of mammalian embryos and embryo and sperm cryopreservation. Basic molecular biological procedures preparation of genomic DNA and genotyping by PCR is desirable. Since we are doing time long experiments it is necessary take care about living cells and animals during weekend according lab schedule.
